Thank you so much Mr. Nishan for your hard work and your professionalism towards my Case. Because of you , today, I am a legal alien of the United States.



Everything went well except for one question I answered incorrectly--- I knew the correct answer and said something different due to stress! Besides that, everything else went smoothly, and it was a great day not only for me but for the entire family.

They gave me a document saying "You passed" and "Congratulations! Your application has been recommended for approval" in bold letters.

We were told that they don't do the ceremony on the same day. I should be receiving a letter with the date for the citizenship ceremony, which should be sometime in the middle of October. They could have scheduled it earlier, but Cliff and I will be traveling to Albany and Buffalo --- so we needed to schedule it for mid October. I am assuming that they will send you a copy of the letter as well.

I will let you know about the date of the ceremony. You are more than welcome to share the ceremony event with us if you wish and/or have the time to do so. Cliff's parents will be there and I think a few members of the family that live down here in Florida.

We will celebrate after the ceremony, and it would be nice to have you amongst the Day's.

We celebrated today anyway, even though that I was told that I can't legally say that I am a citizen.....

A beautifully decorated red/white/blue cake and balloons with touching anticipated congratulations was made.

We took some pictures that I will send you when I can proudly and legally say "I am an American Citizen!".
